opens and closes a circuit

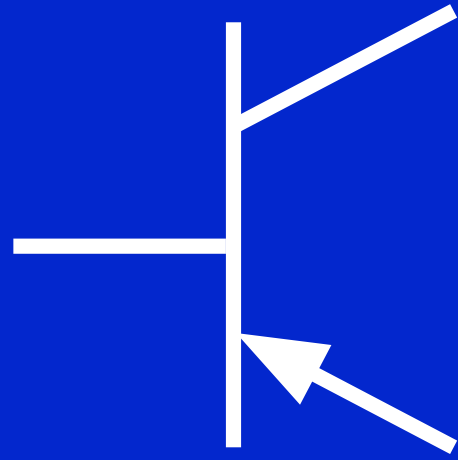

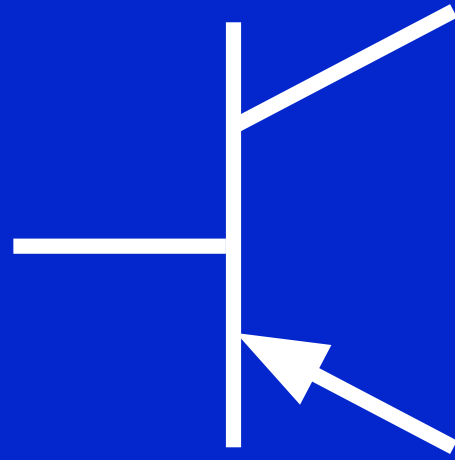
An electronic device that

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What is a transistor?

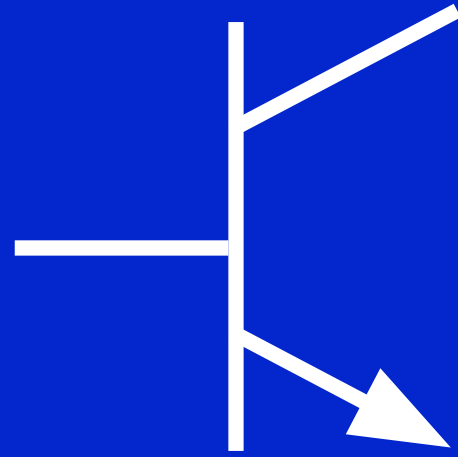


A transistor that allows
current to flow unless
voltage is applied to B

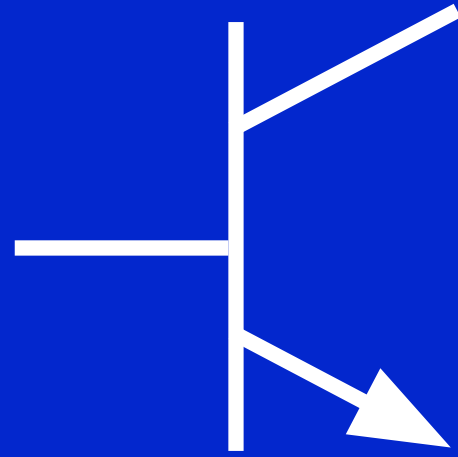


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What is a PNP transistor?



Allows current to flow
between two wires only
when voltage is applied to B



Allows current to flow
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What is an NPN transistor?

The transistor state that
allows current to flow freely

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What is saturation?

Current flows between these
two pins (or not), controlled
by the bias voltage

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What are the collector and emitter pins?

This Boolean logic gate
is built from two NPN
transistors in series

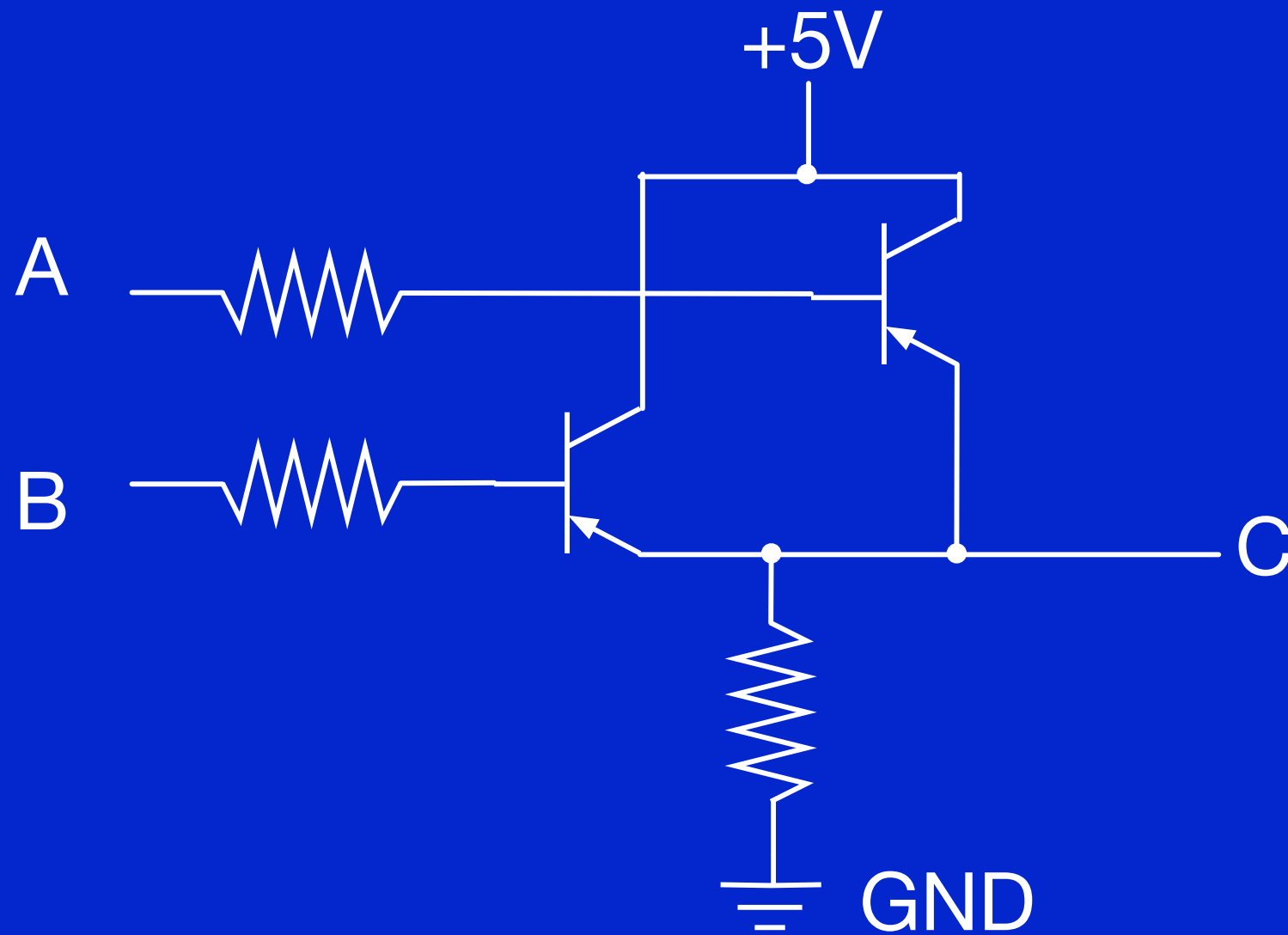
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What is an AND gate?

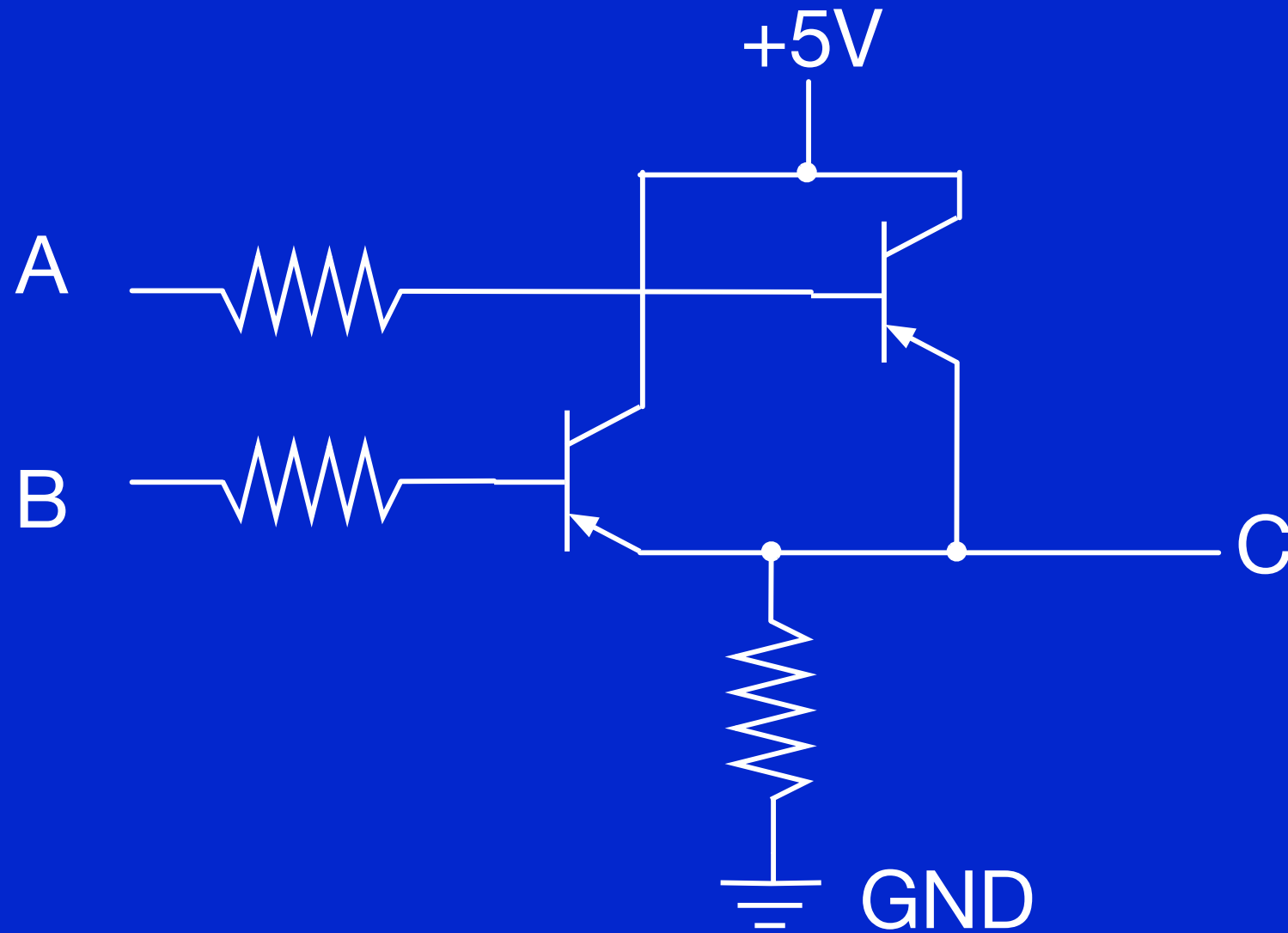
This Boolean logic gate
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transistors in parallel

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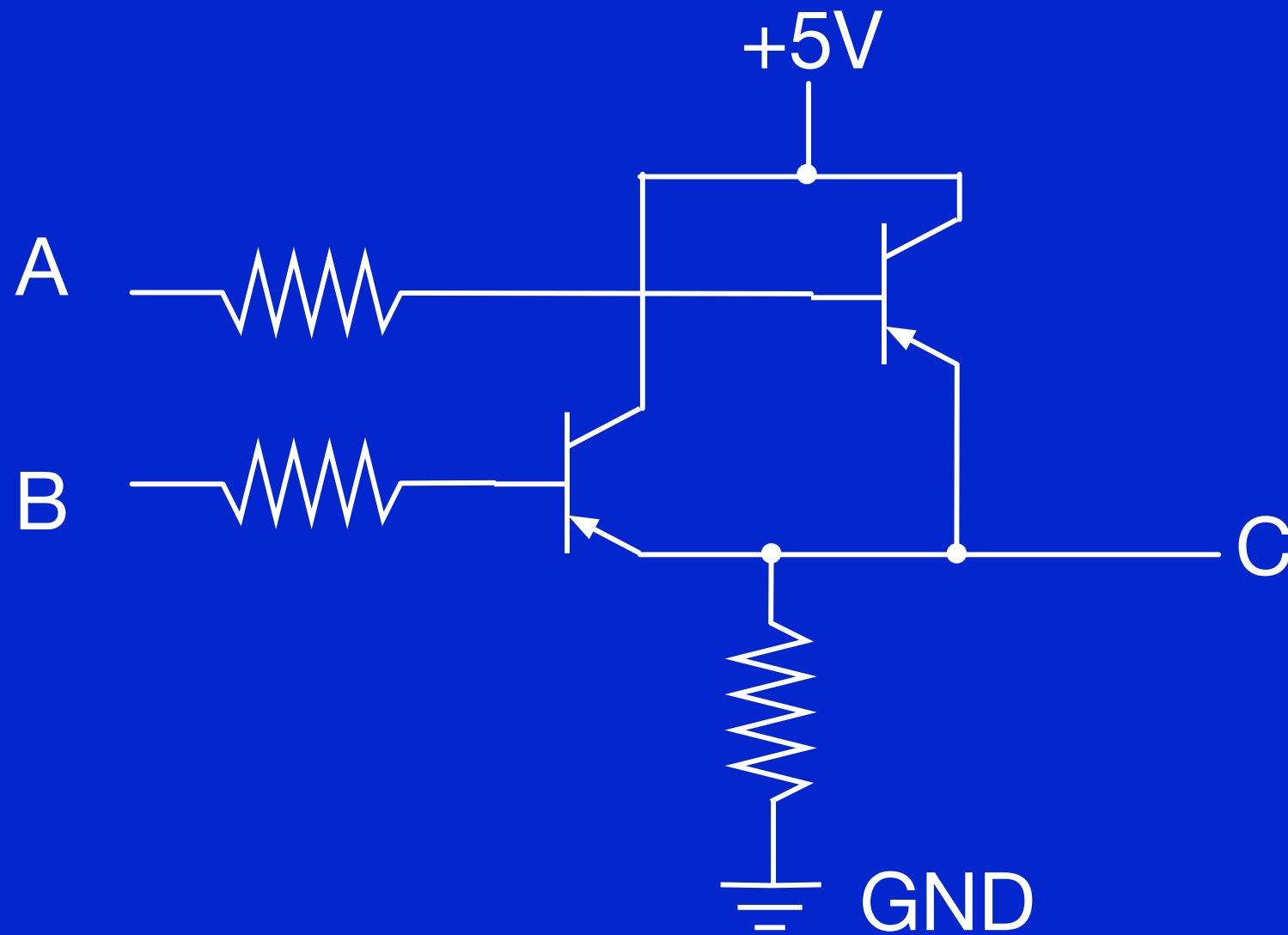
What is an OR gate?



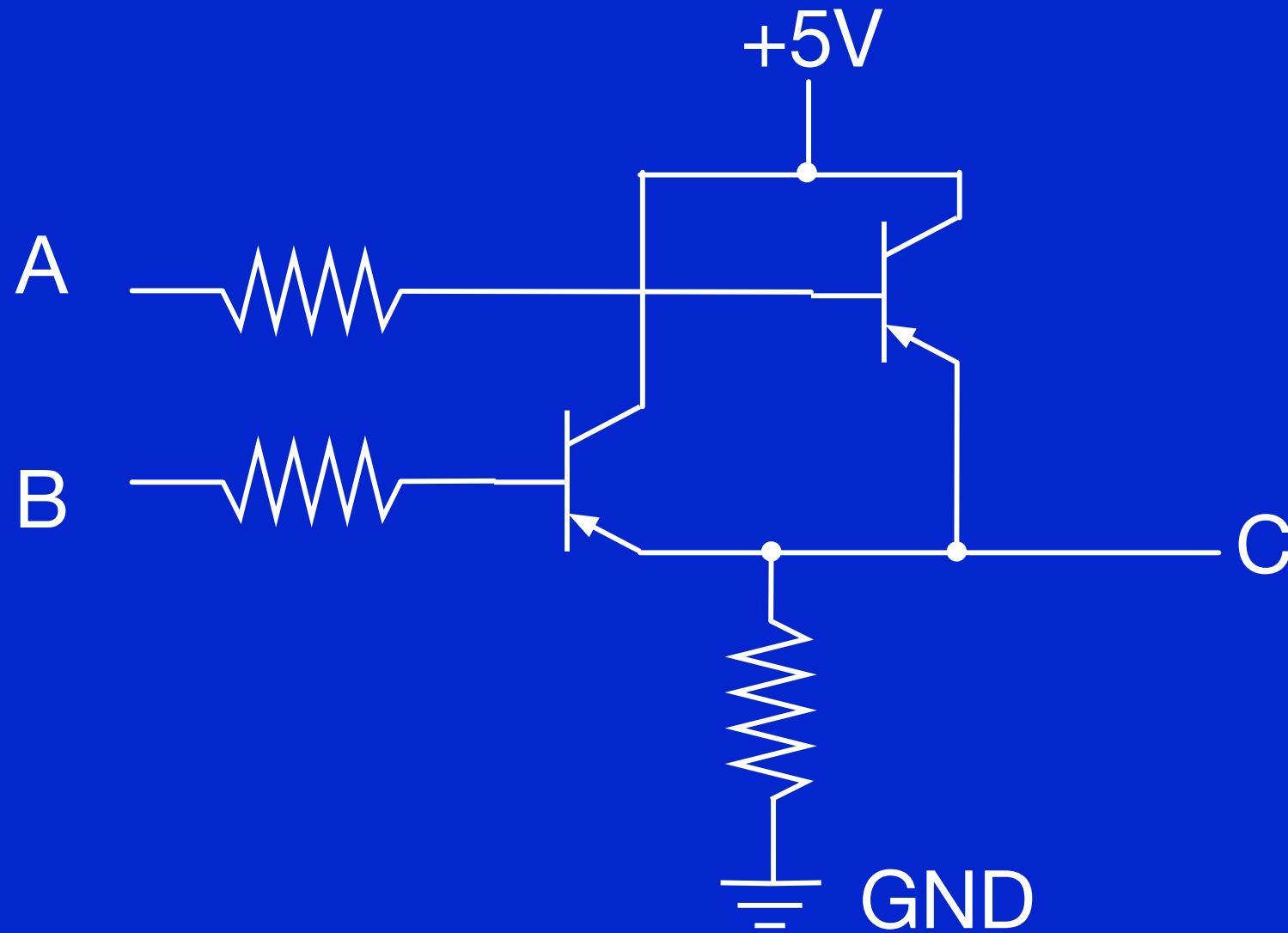
The voltage at C when A

What is +5V?

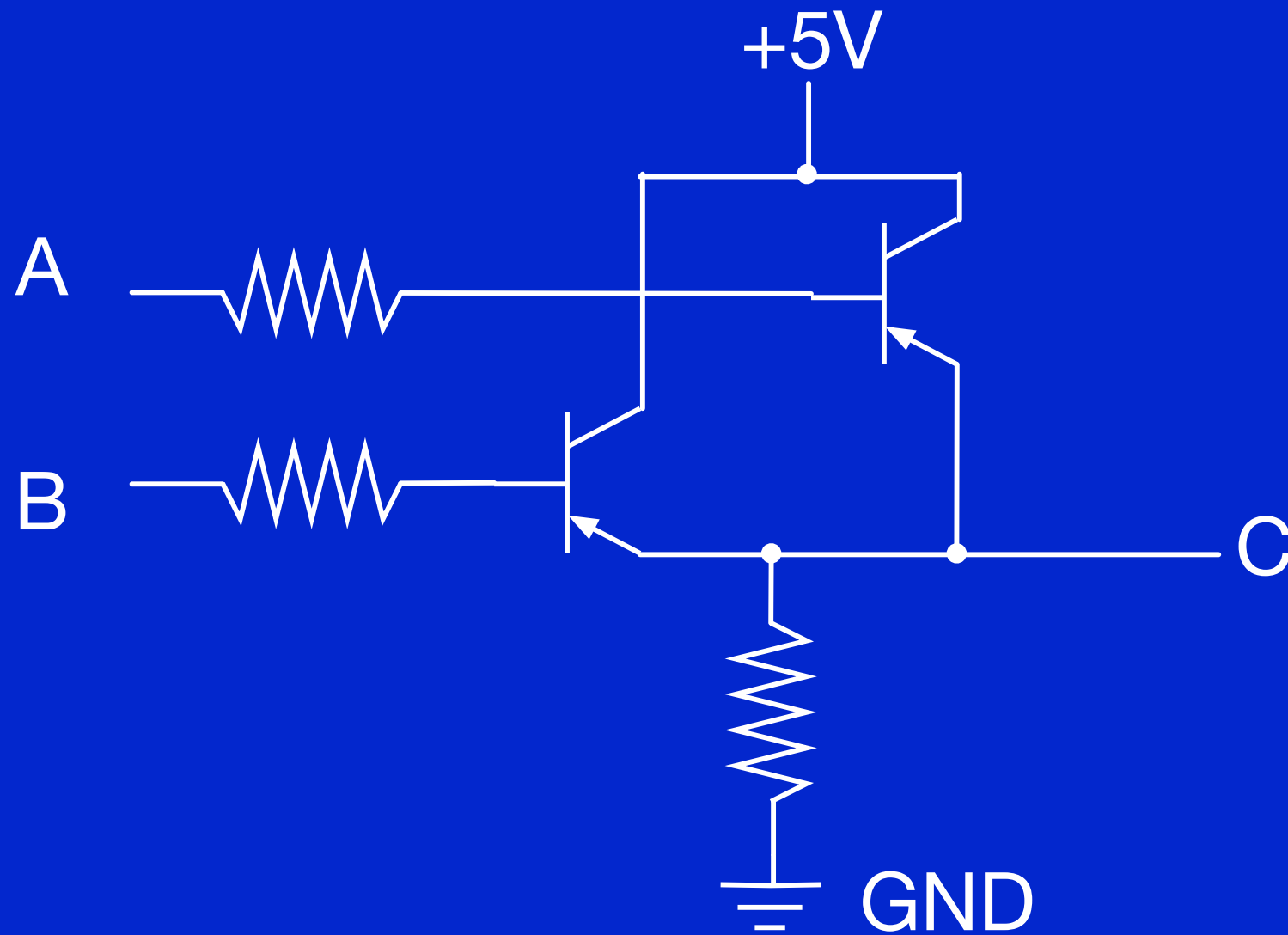


The voltage at A and B if
C is at GND voltage

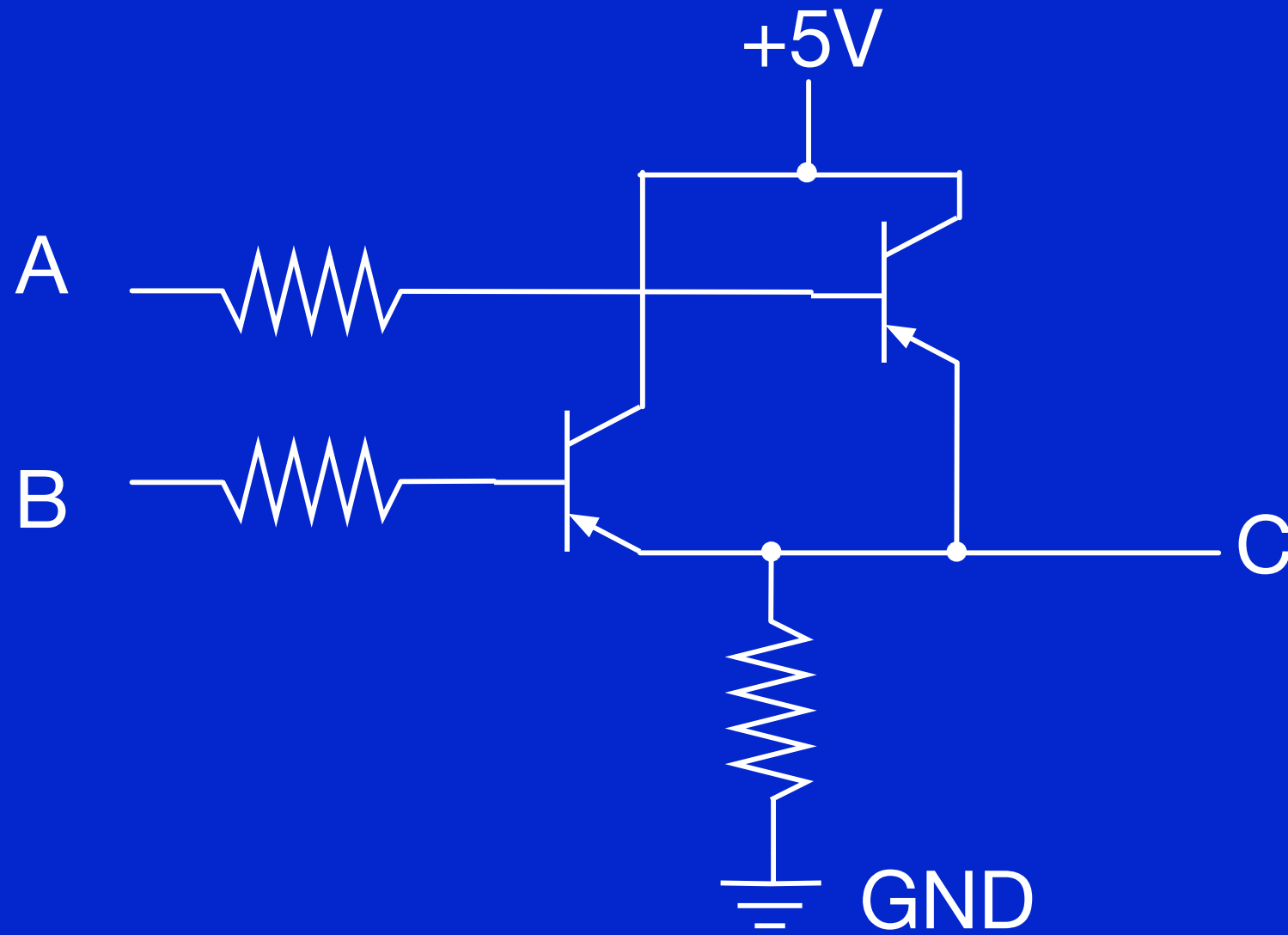


The voltage at A and B if

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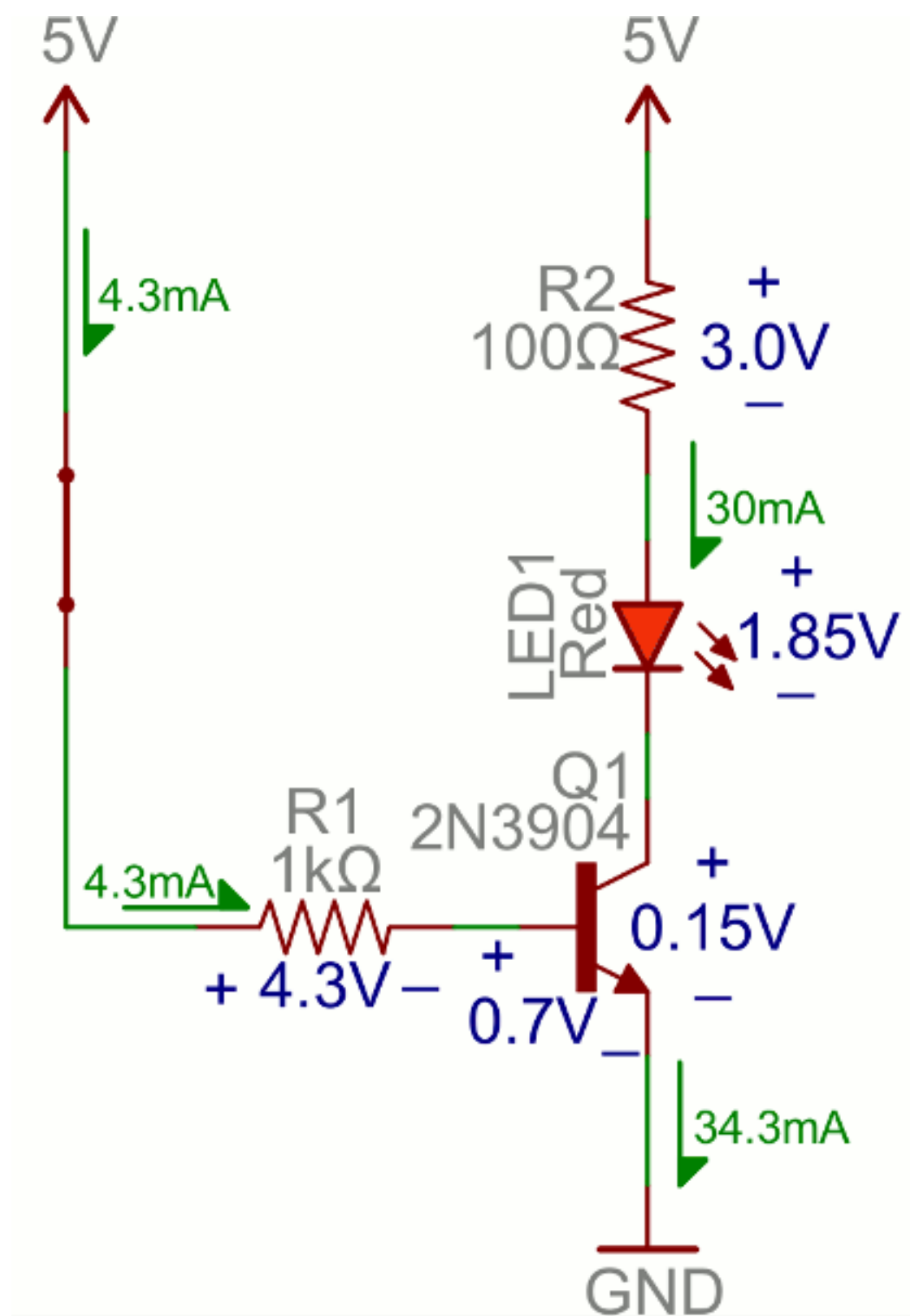

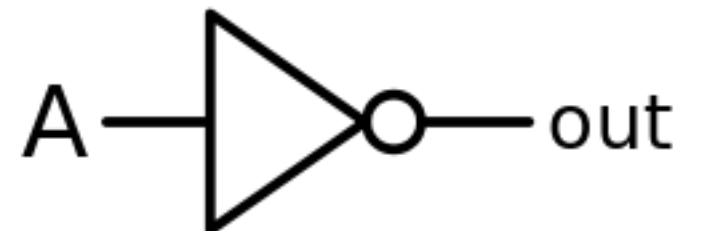
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
